

## \$125,000,000 4.125% Fixed-to-Floating Rate Subordinated Notes due 2030

## **Term Sheet**

**Issuer:** Veritex Holdings, Inc. (the "Company" or "Issuer")

Security: 4.125% Fixed-to-Floating Rate Subordinated Notes due 2030 (the "Notes")

**Aggregate Principal Amount:** \$125,000,000

**Expected Ratings:** BBB- by Kroll Bond Rating Agency

**Coupon:** From and including the Settlement Date to, but excluding, October 15, 2025, or the earlier redemption date (the

"fixed rate period"), the Notes will bear interest at a rate of 4.125% per year, payable semiannually in arrears. From and including October 15, 2025 to, but excluding, the Maturity Date, or the earlier redemption date (the "floating rate period"), the Notes will bear interest at a floating rate per year equal to the Benchmark rate (which is expected to be Three-Month Term SOFR) (each as defined and subject to the provisions described in the Preliminary Prospectus Supplement under "Description of the Notes — Payment of Principal and Interest") plus 399.5 basis points, payable quarterly in arrears; *provided*, *however*, that if the Benchmark rate is less than zero,

the Benchmark rate shall be deemed to be zero.

Interest Payment Dates: Fixed rate period: April 15 and October 15 of each year, commencing on April 15, 2021. The last interest

payment date for the fixed rate period will be October 15, 2025.

Floating rate period: January 15, April 15, July 15 and October 15 of each year, commencing on January 15,

2026.

**Record Dates:** Fixed rate period: April 1 and October 1

Floating rate period: January 1, April 1, July 1 and October 1

**Day Count Convention:** Fixed rate period: 30/360.

Floating rate period: 360-day year and the number of days actually elapsed.

**Optional Redemption:** The Company may redeem the Notes, at its sole option, beginning with the interest payment date of October 15,

2025 and on any interest payment date thereafter, in whole or in part, subject to prior approval of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System (the "Federal Reserve Board"), to the extent such approval is then required under the rules of the Federal Reserve Board, at a redemption price equal to 100% of the principal amount of the Notes to be redeemed, plus accrued and unpaid interest to, but excluding, the redemption date (as described in the Preliminary Prospectus Supplement under "Description of the Notes—Optional Redemption and

Redemption Upon Special Events").

**Special Redemption:** The Notes may not otherwise be redeemed by the Company prior to the Maturity Date, except the Company may,

at its option, redeem the Notes before the Maturity Date in whole, but not in part, subject to prior approval of the Federal Reserve Board, to the extent such approval is then required under the rules of the Federal Reserve Board, upon the occurrence of (i) a "Tax Event", (ii) a "Tier 2 Capital Event", or (iii) the Company becoming required to register as an investment company under the Investment Company Act of 1940, as amended, in each case, at a redemption price equal to 100% of the principal amount of the Notes, plus any accrued and unpaid interest to, but excluding, the redemption date (as described in the Preliminary Prospectus Supplement under "Description of the

Notes—Optional Redemption and Redemption Upon Special Events").

**Denominations:** 

\$1,000 minimum denominations and \$1,000 integral multiples thereof.

**Use of Proceeds:** 

The Company intends to use the net proceeds from this offering for general corporate purposes, including to the potential payment of outstanding indebtedness, and supporting capital levels at Veritex Community Bank.

**Price to Public:**

Ranking:

The Notes will be the Company's general unsecured subordinated obligations and will be:

- · junior in right of payment and upon liquidation to any of the Company's future senior indebtedness, whether secured or unsecured:
- equal in right of payment and upon liquidation with any of the Company's existing and future subordinated indebtedness the terms of which provide that such indebtedness ranks equally with promissory notes, bonds, debentures and other evidences of indebtedness of types that include the Notes;
- senior in right of payment and upon liquidation with the Company's existing junior subordinated debentures underlying outstanding trust preferred securities and any indebtedness the terms of which provide that such indebtedness ranks junior to promissory notes, bonds, debentures and other types of indebtedness that include the Notes; and
- effectively subordinated to all of the existing and future indebtedness, deposits and other liabilities of Veritex
  Community Bank and the Company's other current and future subsidiaries, including, without limitation,
  Veritex Community Bank's liabilities to depositors in connection with the deposits in Veritex Community
  Bank, its liabilities to general creditors and its liabilities arising during the ordinary course or otherwise.

As of June 30, 2020, the Company had \$110.0 million of subordinated indebtedness on a gross basis (which was comprised of the Company's other outstanding subordinated notes) outstanding ranking equally with the Notes and \$33.9 million of junior subordinated indebtedness on a gross basis (which was comprised of the Company's existing junior subordinated debentures underlying outstanding trust preferred securities) outstanding ranking junior to the Notes.

\*Note: The Issuer expects that delivery of the Notes will be made against payment therefor on or about the Settlement Date indicated above, which will be the third business day following the date of pricing of the Notes (this settlement cycle being referred to as "T+3"). Under Rule 15c6-1 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended, trades in the secondary market generally are required to settle in two business days, unless the parties to any such trade expressly agree otherwise.
